Description: Products covered: (ICS:91.100.10) Cement. Gypsum. Lime. Mortar

This addendum concerns the notification of the Ministerial Decree No. 561 /2022 (2 pages, in Arabic) that gives the producers and importers a six-month transitional period to abide by the Egyptian Standard ES 4756-1 "Cement - Part 1: Composition, specifications and conformity criteria for common cements." (48 pages, in Arabic).

It should be noted that the Ministerial Decree No. 423/2005 (25 pages, in Arabic) which was formerly notified in G/TBT/N/EGY/3 dated 14 December 2005 mandated among others the earlier version of this Egyptian standard.

Worth mentioning is that this standard is technically identical with modification with EN 197-1/2011.

This standard cancels and replaces its last version adopted in 2013.
